SCIENTIFIC PART OVERVIEW

Applicants must upload a document containing the following items (using the calibri font size 11):

- Main hypothesis and state of the art (max. 2 pages)
- Impact and clinical relevance of the proposed research (max. 2 pages)
- Preliminary data (max. 1 page)
- Core of the project: plan of the project over the first 2 terms (max. 5 pages) including a clear distribution of time between their research and clinical activities (Gantt chart or else)
- Methodology & design of the study (max. 3 pages)
- Contingency plan (max. 1 page)
- Assets of the research environment (max. 1 page)
- Ethics and reliability of the project in term of data treatment and management (statistics, processing and storage of the data including compliance with the GDPR) (max. 1 page)
- Bibliography

The above-mentioned sections must be separated by a page break.

All fields are optional, and they should be completed insofar as they are relevant to the research activities the grantee intends to carry out. Applicants should aim to provide the panel members with sufficient and relevant information to support an accurate evaluation of their application. Applicants may submit a KCIG project proposal within a single overarching research line that can be developed into multiple distinct research projects with other international research teams.
